

# **2010 STRATFORD CHAMPIONSHIP JERSEY SHOW**

## **Rules and Regulations**

1. This competition is restricted to registered purebred and 75% percentage, or greater, purebred Jerseys.
2. Arrival time for cattle begins at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 18, 2010. Shavings will be available for sale on site. Straw is being supplied by John Deere Limited.
3. The entry fee will be \$15.00 per animal with no entry required for group classes. **Entries close Friday, September 10, 2010 at 9:00 a.m.** Fees must accompany entries and there will be a late entry fee of \$20.00/exhibit. **4-H calves must be the 2010 4-H project of the leads person and must be entered in an open class under the above requirements. Faxed entries MUST have accompanying payment by credit card (Mastercard or Visa) or they will not be accepted. Email entries must follow up with faxed payment confirmation. Late entries will not be catalogued.**
4. There are no production requirements to enter. However, there will be a production award based on total kilograms of butterfat for each milking class (Senior 2 year olds through to Mature Cow). To qualify for this award, the animal must have a completed 305 day record. Production Records must be available for verification prior to the show. **SPONSORED by Gay Lea Food Inc.**
5. There is no restriction on the number of entries an exhibitor may show.
6. Substitution is limited to two (2) animals at \$20.00 per substitution.
7. **Notice to all exhibitors with milking animals. We have a bulk tank for good quality milk that we sell and the money helps subsidize our show costs. There will also be containers ("Barrels") for milk that does not meet our standards. We would appreciate your cooperation in this matter.**
8. Farm signs and posted pedigrees are encouraged in barn exhibits.
9. The Mandatory Exhibitors Agreement must be signed by the exhibitor before any animals from that exhibitor can be shown.
10. SHOW HARNESS will be required in lieu of hat bands.
11. All animals must have plastic panel NLID tags.
12. Each exhibitor shall hold the show management blameless for any loss or accident. It shall also be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall be responsible for any injury or damage that may be occasioned to any person or things whomsoever or whatsoever against all claims or demands for loss or damage occasioned thereby. Every exhibitor must carry liability insurance. In most cases exhibitors are covered with the farm liability for up to five shows. Please check with your

insurance company.

### **Code of Ethics for Exhibitors**

**The Stratford Championship Jersey Show has an ethics committee to deal with any problems that may arise at this Show. All exhibitors must comply with the “Code of Ethics for Dairy Shows “ as endorsed by the Canadian Dairy Breeds.**

## **General Rules & Information**

1. Premier Breeder Award ( donated by Quality Seeds Ltd )and Premier Exhibitor Award (donated by Quality Seeds Ltd.) will be awarded on the following basis:

Premium Breeder- An attractive director’s chair will be presented to the individual, partnership or institution having the largest number of points that have been won in the individual classes by not more than seven animals, bred, but necessarily owned by the winner. In the case of jointly owned animals, the joint ownership will be considered as one exhibitor and no part of the points awarded will count toward the individual point total of any of the joint owner. All animals must bear the same prefix. Points will be awarded on the following basis.

#### **Premier Exhibitor**

An attractive director’s chair will be presented to the exhibitor winning the greatest number of points on animals owned by an Exhibitor. Points will be awarded the same as Premier Breeder based on an exhibit of seven animals.

2. Judging will commence at 9:30 a.m. with the junior animals & the milking animals will start at 1230.
3. Registration papers and production certificates must be made available for checking the day previous to the show. A \$5.00 penalty per entry will be assessed to any entry that cannot be checked by 6:00 p.m.
4. All classes will receive ribbons supplied by the Stratford & District Agricultural Society.

There will be 2 Showmanship Classes. No entry fee is required and no production qualifications needed. Exhibits must be pre entered for Showmanship Classes.

In the Open Show the highest 2 places will be asked to step forward in their individual Class & will be shown for Champion 4-H calf following the Jr. Champion Class. 4-H calves will be Eligible for an All-Canadian 4-H nomination.  
**Class 12. Junior Herd**, group of 3 junior animals bred by the exhibitor and at least 1 owned by the exhibitor.  
**Class 13. Milking Senior Yearling**, born Sept 1, 2008 to November 30, 2008.  
**Class 14. Junior 2 Year Old**, born Mar 1, to Aug 31, 2008  
**Class 15. Senior 2 Year Old**, born Sept 1, 2007 to Feb 28, 2008  
**Class 16. Junior 3 Year Old**, born Mar 1, to Aug 31, 2007  
**Class 17. Senior 3 Year Old**, born Sept 1, 2006 to Sep. 28, 2007  
**Class 18. 4 Year Old**, born Sept 1, 2005 o Aug 31, 2006 In milk If dry, must be within approximately 8 of calving.  
**Class 19. 5 Year Old**, born Sept 1, 2004 to Aug 31, 2005 In Milk. If dry, must be with approximately 8 weeks of calving.  
**Class 20. Mature Cow**, born prior to Sept 1, 2004 In Milk. If dry, must be with approximately 8 weeks of calving.  
**Class 21. Grand Champion Female and Reserve.**  
**Class 22. Best Udder** - The judge shall designate the best udder in Classes 15,16,17,18,19 & 20. These designated exhibits shall compete for 1st and 2nd Best Udders in the Show.  
**Class 23. Breeders Herd** - All Animals must be Sr. Animal and carry the same prefix. A breeder must solely own at least one of the animals.
